It gives me great pleasure to be with you this morning at the opening of this Session of the workshop of the department of political science.

Constitutional Values in Vachana's

As we all know, the Indian Constitution is not just a legal document. It is a moral and ethical guide that reflects our collective aspirations for justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity. These are not new concepts to the Indian ethos. In fact, if we look closely, we find deep roots of these values in our own cultural and spiritual heritage — especially in the Vachana literature of the 12th century.

Let us first understand — what are Vachanas?

The Vachanas are simple, yet profound poetic expressions written in Kannada by saints and mystics of the Veerashaiva or Lingayat tradition, most notably Basavanna, Akka Mahadevi, Allama Prabhu, and many others. These were not just literary works — they were voices of social change, calls for spiritual awakening, and powerful critiques of caste hierarchy, ritualism, and discrimination.

Now, let us explore how the constitutional values resonate through the Vachanas.

1. Equality :

Our Constitution guarantees equality before the law and prohibits any form of discrimination on the basis of caste, gender, religion, or race.

Centuries before this was written into law, Basavanna declared:

"No man is high or low, O Lord of the meeting rivers;
It is the deeds that make one noble, not the birth."

This is a direct rejection of caste-based hierarchy and affirms the dignity of every individual, just like Article 14 of our Constitution.

2. Liberty : The Constitution gives us the right to freedom of thought, expression, belief, faith, and worship.

The Vachanakars practiced and preached spiritual liberty — the freedom to seek God without the mediation of priests or rituals.

"Look within, the temple is not outside," said Allama Prabhu.

This was a radical assertion of personal spiritual autonomy, challenging the rigid structures of organized religion — a value completely in tune with our constitutional guarantee of freedom of religion under Article 25.

3. Fraternity :

The value of fraternity, which promotes the unity and integrity of the nation, was deeply emphasized in the Vachanas.

Basavanna envisioned a society where everyone lived as sharana-bandhus — spiritual brothers and sisters, bound by love, compassion, and respect.

"Kayakave Kailasa" — Work is Worship, he said — giving dignity to labor, and erasing social distinctions based on occupation.

This value directly reflects fraternity as mentioned in the Preamble of our Constitution.

4. Justice :

Justice — social, economic, and political — is a cornerstone of our democracy.

The Vachanas were perhaps the earliest voices for social justice in Karnataka and India. They strongly opposed practices that dehumanized people — particularly the caste system and untouchability.

Akka Mahadevi, one of the prominent women Vachana poets, questioned gender discrimination and demanded the right to choose her path — a struggle echoed today in our continuing fight for gender justice.

Conclusion :

Friends, the Vachana movement was not just a spiritual revolution — it was a social and ethical awakening that still holds relevance today. The fact that values preached over 900 years ago align so deeply with the foundational principles of our Constitution is a testament to the timelessness and universality of truth.

As responsible citizens and learners, it is our duty to not only understand these values but also to practice them — in our homes, in our institutions, and in our daily lives.

Let us remember the words of Basavanna:

"Don't rob, don't kill, never lie;

Don't get angry, don't think ill of others.

Don't glorify yourself, don't blame others...

This is the way of wisdom, this is the path to peace."

One of the fundamental principles of the Indian Constitution is equality. Article 14 of the Constitution guarantees equality before the law, and this concept is at the heart of the values that we cherish as a society. In the Vachanas, we find a similar sentiment expressed in many verses.

For example, Basava in his Vachana says:

"The stone is the same whether it is placed in a temple or on the road. The value does not change based on where it is."

This statement not only challenges the superficial distinctions between the sacred and the secular but also draws attention to the inherent equality of all beings. There is no room for caste or class-based discrimination in his teachings. Similarly, the Indian Constitution strives to ensure that all citizens, regardless of their background, have equal rights and opportunities.
