M Vijayavani News Network The preservation of Badami monuments is not limited to the department. It is the responsibility of all of us, said Dr. M.S. Krishnamurthy, retired lecturer, University of Mysore.

Speaking at the World Heritage Day celebrations organized by the Archaeological Survey of India at the Pattadakal temple complex in the taluk,

he said that the Chalukyas had made the temples of Nagara, Dravida and Vesara shikharas a heritage during their rule. These are seen in

a single group only in Pattadakal. This has made Pattadakal a World Heritage

Site. It is noteworthy that the department

has created a good environment for tourists who come in discipline and cleanliness due to the many development works carried out. We should all celebrate the glory of these and pass them on to the next generation, he said.

Dharwad KCD Retired Registrar Dr. S. Rajashekar inaugurated the photo exhibition and said, "When we studied, the temples were undeveloped and unsanitary.

However, today, we all know that the heritage of tourist sites is represented by sculptures.



The World Heritage Day celebration program organized in Pattadakal was inaugurated by Dr. S. Rajashekar, retired registrar of Dharwad KCD. Dr. M.S. Krishnamurthy, Dr. S.V. Venkatesaiah, Ramesh Moolimani and others were present.

He said that efforts should be made to protect as well as respect it. This will increase the respect of this country.

There are many deep things in the study of Chalukya monuments. Today's students should shed light on history by studying the tourist sites and monuments themselves. The monuments of Pattadakal are not limited to the country alone. This is a group of the most wonderful sculptures and beauty that encompasses the human life of the world, he said.

ASI Retired Regional Director T.I. S.V. Venkatesaiah, who presided over the function, said, "When I was an officer in Dharwad zone, I visited many of the three tourist destinations.

Development works have been done. While studying about the Rashtrakutas, my guru Dr. M.S. Krishnamurthy traveled to this area and studied, which gave me the opportunity to work here. He said that young people should learn about history through studying and become employees and also cooperate in developing tourism. Dharwad Zone SA Officer of the Archaeological Survey of India Ramesh Moolimani spoke in the introduction. S.B.M. Lecturer of Degree College S.S. Dodamani, Srigruru Bhagi and others were present. The students were awarded certificates. Devaraj welcomed and thanked them.
